- V. President Reports

Muffin Cart:

- Muffin Cart really needs help on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays
- The Halloween Muffin Cart day was a disappointment
- Overall the Muffin Cart has gotten out more

- Spanish hallway wants the cart; Can only do this if we have two students come out at a time and go back to class.
- Will not sell to kids who ask their friends to pay for them; too distracting
- If we can find other carts then we can do both sides of the school (one can do back halls and one can do the front halls)
- Kids must be on their best behavior and not ask if we have change for the \$50 or \$100 bills they bring
- There is crowding in The Commons and the bus kids need to get to their buses. Suggestion is to have a divider/sign for the bus kids. Dr. Turner will come help during this timeframe.
