Scholarship



Purpose:

To award up to five (5) scholarships to students who meet the eligibility criteria and have successfully demonstrated growth through one of the five (5) pillars of North Stafford High School – No Excuses, Optimism, Resiliency, Team Work, Honesty. The number of scholarships and the monetary value of each will be determined based on the revenue generated from the annual membership drive.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Must be a current year member of the PTSO (Family or Student Membership) by March 2026.
2. Minimum of 5 hours of volunteering by Student or Family
3. Have a cumulative academic GPA of 3.0 or higher
4. Complete the Scholarship Application and Essay
5. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation
6. Application packet must be submitted in a sealed envelope to Mr. Daney in the Counseling Office by April 15, 2026.

Decision Criteria:

Application packets will be reviewed and voted on by a 5-7 member committee chosen by the PTSO Executive Board. Committee members may be PTSO Board Members, teachers, counselors, and faculty. Members of the PTSO Board that have a senior student are ineligible to be on the selection committee.
